LIBERTY, CAPITALISM, THE AMERICAN FOUNDING AND MORAL CHARACTER


The Lyceum Scholars Program at Clemson University offers an education aimed at shaping students' minds and character, all while providing the benefits of a small liberal arts community within a large research university.

Not only are ideas enduring, but they also shape the world around us. For this reason, the Lyceum Scholars Program, first and foremost, studies ideas. Adopting a great books approach to the study of the moral, political and economic foundations of a free society, the Lyceum Scholars Program invites students to take themselves and political life seriously. Lyceum Scholars do this through a series of eight classes, ranging from ancient political thought to the political thought of the American founding to constitutional law. While the Lyceum Scholars Program is open to students of any major, those who complete this course of study fulfill the requirements for a minor in political science, and six of the eight courses count toward the political science major at Clemson University.



Applicants to the Lyceum Scholars Program undergo a rigorous screening process that includes three written essays and an interview. Students accepted into the program receive a privately funded \$10,000 scholarship disbursed over four years.
